

Brief Profile of Shri Susheel Kumar



Shri Susheel Kumar, Secretary, Department of Border Management, Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India is a member of 1982 batch of the Indian Administrative Service (IAS) and has about 36 years of experience in Government at senior levels.

He did his M.Sc. and M.Phil. in Physics from University of Delhi, India and later acquired MBA degree from University of Birmingham, U.K. He has worked and acquired experience in sectors of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Housing, Urban Development, Industries, Textiles, Commerce, Tourism, Water Resources, Shipping and General Administration.

He played a key role in developing the concept of and later drafting the Real Estate (Regulation and Development) Bill which ultimately became an Act in 2016. As Chairman of Central Pollution Control Board he introduced many new ideas in the field of pollution abatement e.g. Air Quality Index (AQI), On-line Real time water Quality Stations & On-line Real time continuous Emission & Effluent Monitoring Stations.

He was the chief negotiator of India during the Multilateral Climate Change Negotiations under United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC). The Indian team under his leadership participated in Ad-hoc Durban Platform (ADP) negotiations as well as other two subsidiary bodies of UNFCCC, namely SBSTA & SBI. He also guided the work from Indian side under Inter Governmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC).
